

AV and TRAAVI sign MOU

Last week, Acting CEO Anthony Carlyon and Acting ED Enterprise Services Jesse Maddison joined members of The Retired Ambulance Association of Victoria Incorporated (TRAAVI) at Doncaster HQ to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).

TRAAVI is a not-for-profit incorporated association open to all current and former members of ambulance services within Victoria. It plays a vital role in providing welfare support, peer engagement, and advocacy for retired ambulance personnel.

TRAAVI's work directly supports AV's community and reputation goals. It provides valuable services such as maintaining legacy publications, offering peer support for mental health and physical injury post-service, and representing AV's values in public forums and events.

Re-entering into an MOU formalises these arrangements, introduces governance safeguards, and enables sustainable partnership planning by:

- Recognising the service of retired staff and promoting ongoing connection.
- Enhancing AV's ability to communicate with a legacy workforce and support their advocacy.
- Providing a structured framework for peer-based support, including in areas such as post-employment injury and mental health.
- Encouraging collaborative messaging and connection via TRAAVI's website and social media channels.

The partnership reflects AV's commitment to honouring the past contributions of its workforce while strengthening community ties and workplace culture.
